Sub:- Agitation against anti employees activities-Intimation-Regarding -

Ref:- ITEF MP&CG circle's letter F. No. आकमस/मप्रछग/2015 dated 27 and 30th January 2015.

Kindly refer to the above.

It is an irony of fate that the admn is turned deaf ears when the entire Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh charge is perforce treading the path of agitation in the form of peaceful launch break demonstration for their legitimate demands and against the autocratic style of functioning of the administration which is causing harassment to our members. It has been made thread bare clear vide our letters dtd.27.01.2015 and 30.01.2015 that the inaction or anti employees action by the administration is creating unbearable circumstances throughout the region. As there was no response to the letter dtd 27.01.2015, the entire membership of Non-gazatted employees went on agitational activities i.e. demonstration, General body etc. during lunch break from 29.01.2015 at 1.30 to 2.00 pm. The branches/charges have made requests to the in PCCIT to kindly intervene and settle the issue through dialogue in a cordial atmosphere. The same is enclosed herewith. Till 3rd Feb 2015 the peaceful agitation of lunch hour demonstration is continued but no positive decision or discussion and decision was there at the end of admn. Hence we

are left with no other alternative but to intensify the agitation. Accordingly a massive Non-Co-operation movement (which includes Non-participation in any Survey/search operations, Non-preparation and submission of any Statistical reports barring parliament questions and not attending the offices on Saturday, Sunday & holidays and sitting late after office hrs.) will start from 4th Feb. 2015 to 6th Feb. 2015. If no Settlement is arrived at between these three days period, We, as decided by the all the working committee members of ITEF MP and CG circle, will be compelled to further intensify the programme by observing a massive walk out on 9th Feb 2015. The situation which is prevailing in this region is created by the lethargic style of functioning of the Admn and we should not be held responsible for jeopardized functioning of the official activities. Sir, we are still hopeful that this deadlock will be broken, our demands will be full filled and normalcy will prevail in the region.

CHARTER OF DEMANDS

1. Determine the seniority of all cadres other than ITIs as per instructions of CBDT in the wake of N.R. Parmar Case.
2. Accord Seniority wef 1st January 2015 in accordance with the CBDT directions for DPC of R.Y. 2014-15 to all the officials who were not promoted due to lack of approach of the admn on 21st Dec. 2014 and promoted after 1st Jan 2015.
3. Release the names of ITIs whose promotion was with hold for want of ACRs of earlier years as mentioned in the order No. 23 dtd 01.01.2015. All ACRs have been duly received in the office of the Pr. CCIT, Bhopal on the next day.
4. Settle the pending cases of Compassionate appointments.
5. Give MACP to those candidates whose names were not released in the name of Non receipt of vigilance clearance certificates.
6. provide sufficient work space to all officials following the creation of offices in new dispensation of cadre restricting.
7. Transfer all the officials retained since long in the Investigation wing where LPC's approval is required according to the RJCM policies.
8. The unwilling interstate transfers of ITIs made vide order No. 38 may kindly be cancelled stayed upto AGT 2015.
9. The transfer of union functionaries namely Shri Bhim Singh Meena and Kishan Vyas which was made at the be haste of CIT Gwalior/Ujjain respectively by making admn grounds may kindly be cancelled forthwith.
10. Acceed the transfer applications of TA/STA/others submitted on mutual agreed basis.
